Step by step assembly instructions

Step One

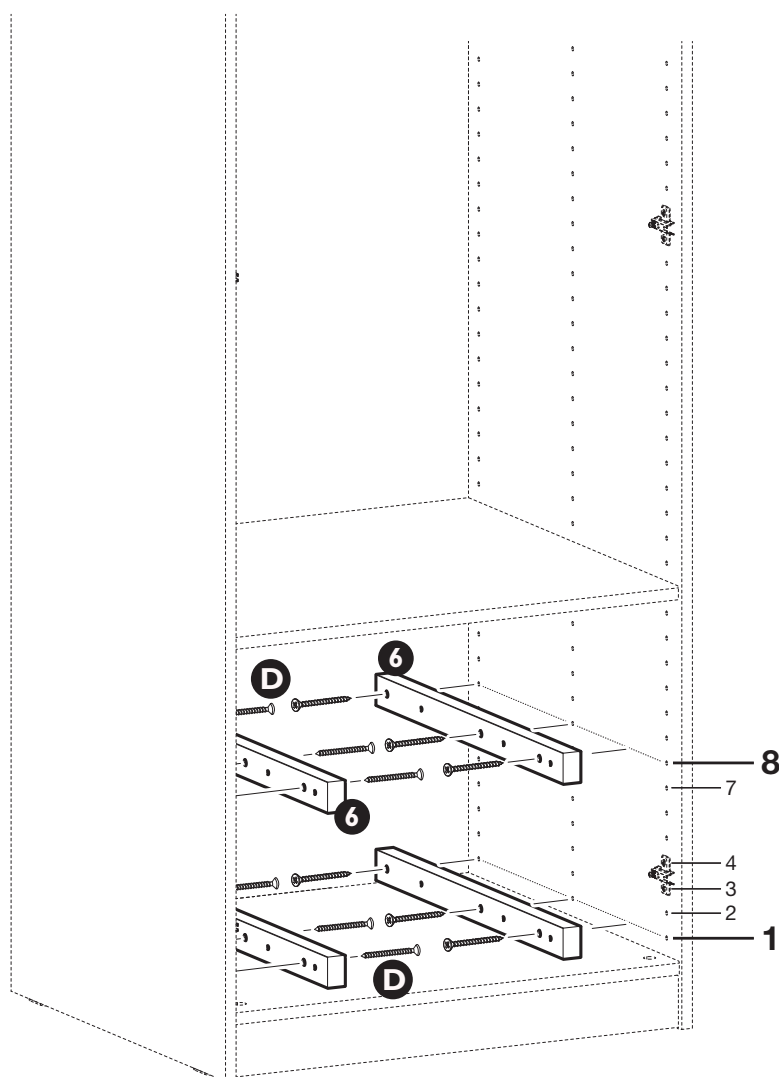
1. Insert 8x threaded bush (G) into the holes on side panels as shown, with the help of a hammer.

Step Two

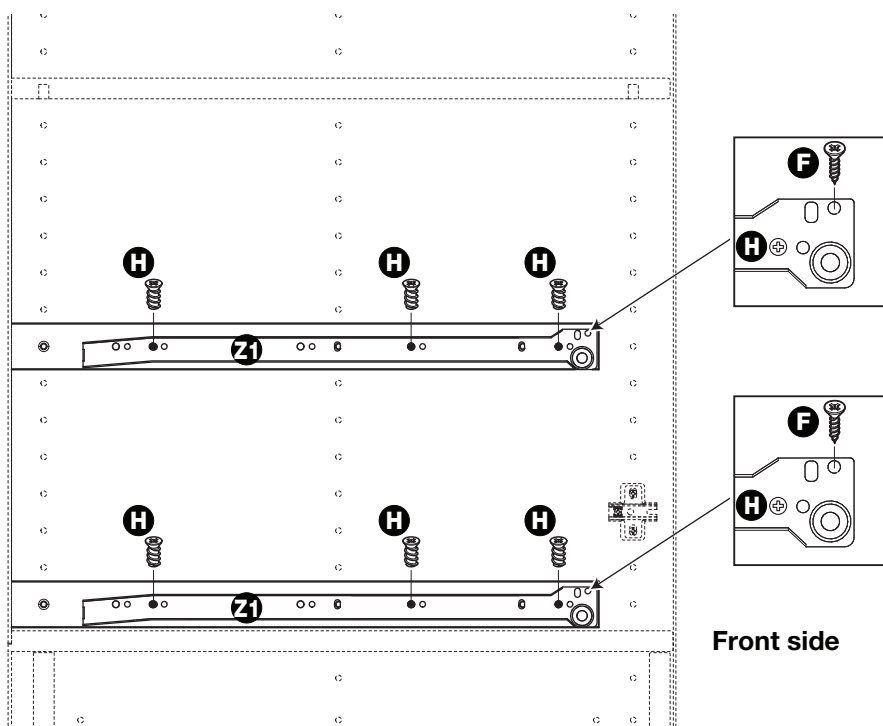
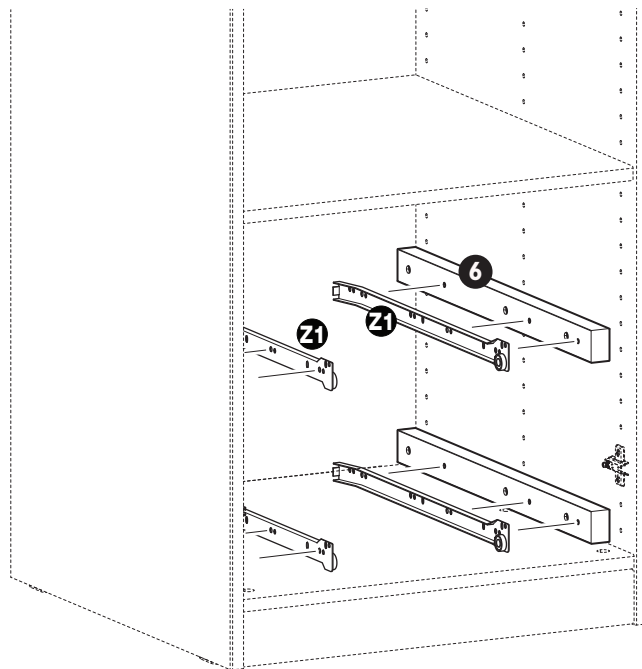
1. Fix 4x spacers (6) to side panels through holes shown in the view using 12x screws (D).

Step Three

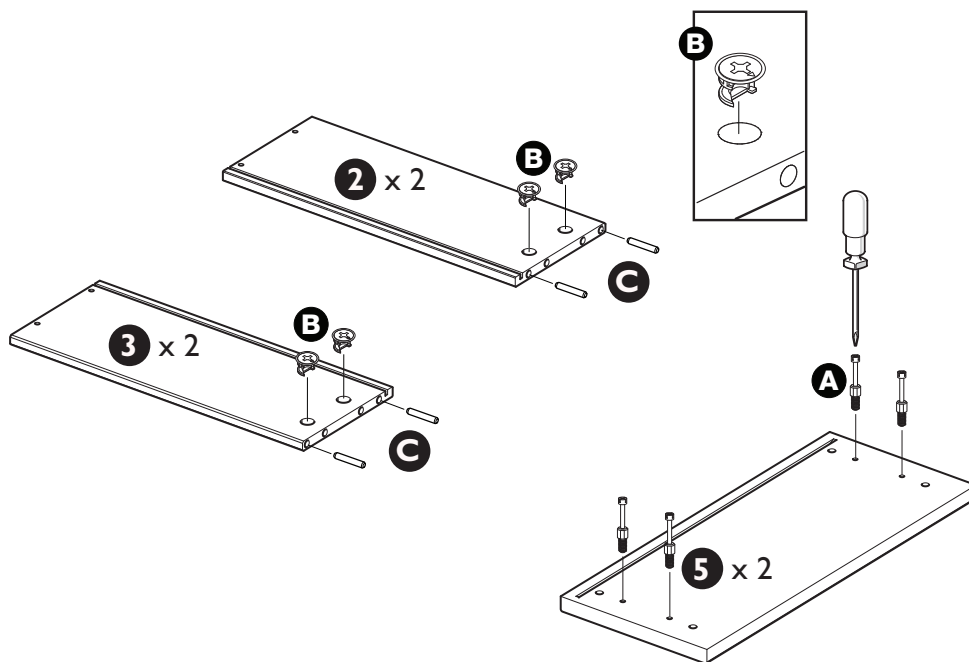
1. Fix 4x runner parts (Z1) to the spacers (6) through holes shown in the detail view using 12x euroscrews (H) and 4x screws (F).



Step by step assembly instructions

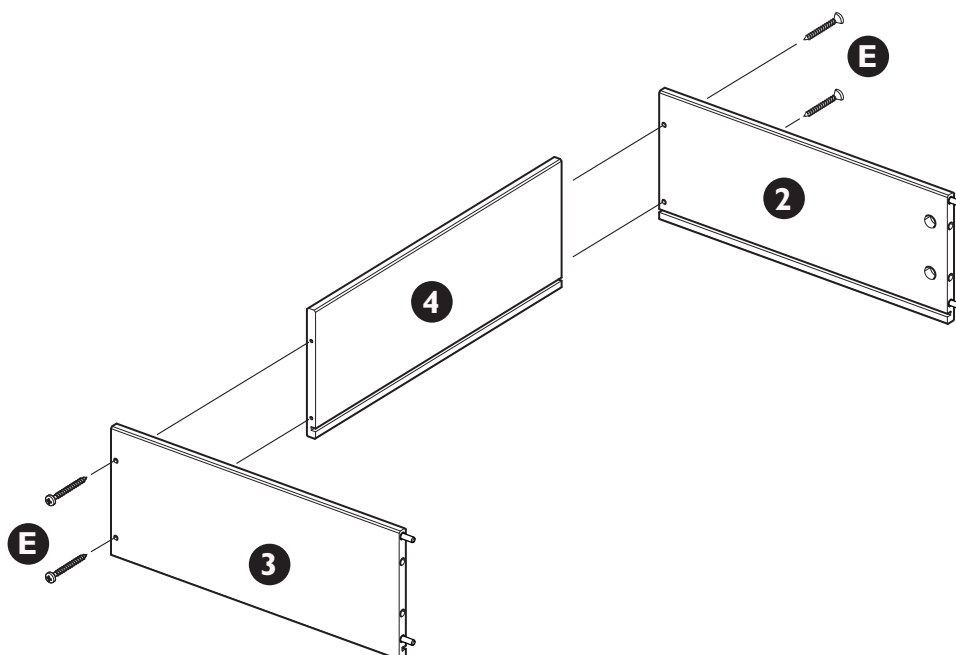
Step Four

1. Attach 4x wooden dowels (C) into the pre-drilled holes on drawer sides (2) (3) as shown, repeat for all drawers.
2. Place the cam lock (B) into the holes on drawer sides (2) (3) as shown, arrow pointing towards the bolt, repeat for all drawers.
3. Attach 4x metal dowels (A) into the pre-drilled holes on drawer front (5). Use a screwdriver to turn fitting (A) clockwise to fix, repeat for all drawers.



Step Five

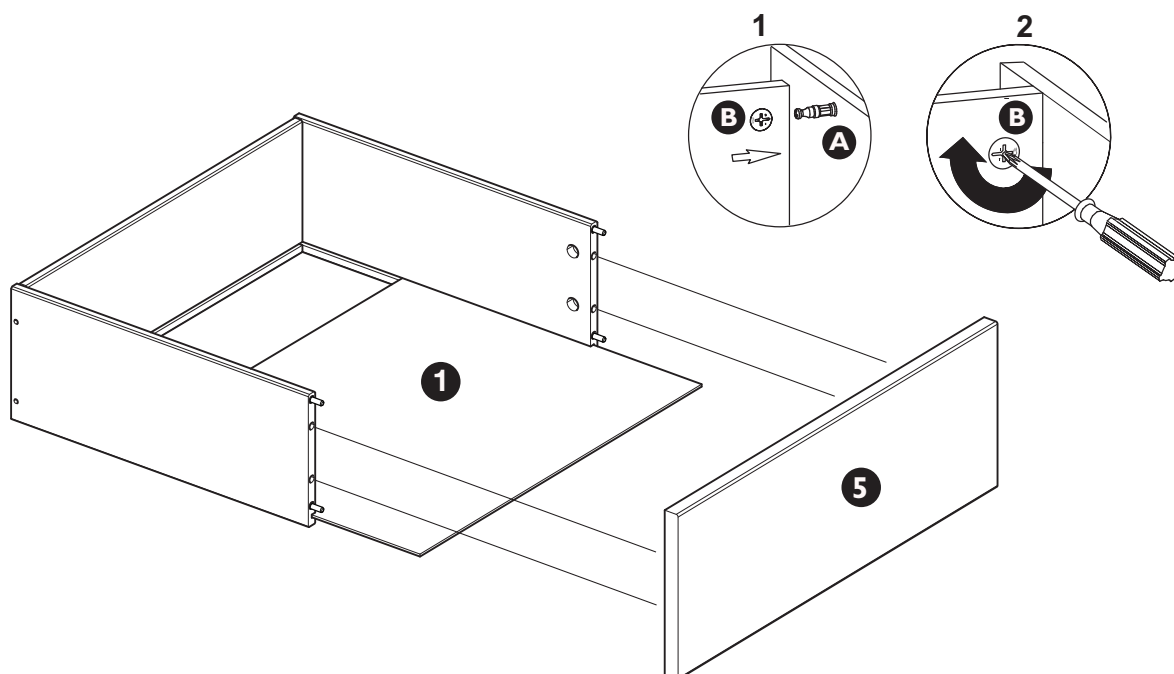
1. Fit the RH (2) and LH (3) drawer sides to the drawer back (4) using 30 mm screws (E), repeat for all drawers.

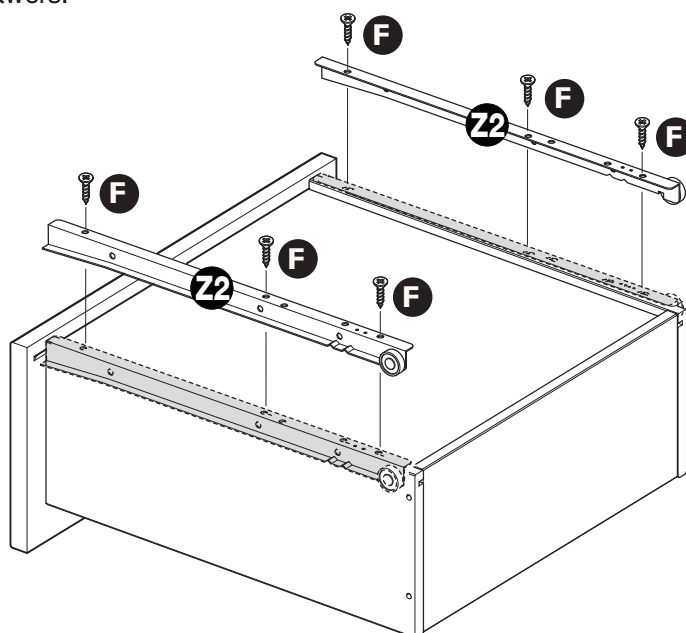
Step Six

1. Slide drawer bottom panel (1) into the drawer box grooves.
2. Position drawer front (5) onto drawer box, turn locking nuts (B) clockwise to lock.
repeat for all drawers



Step Seven

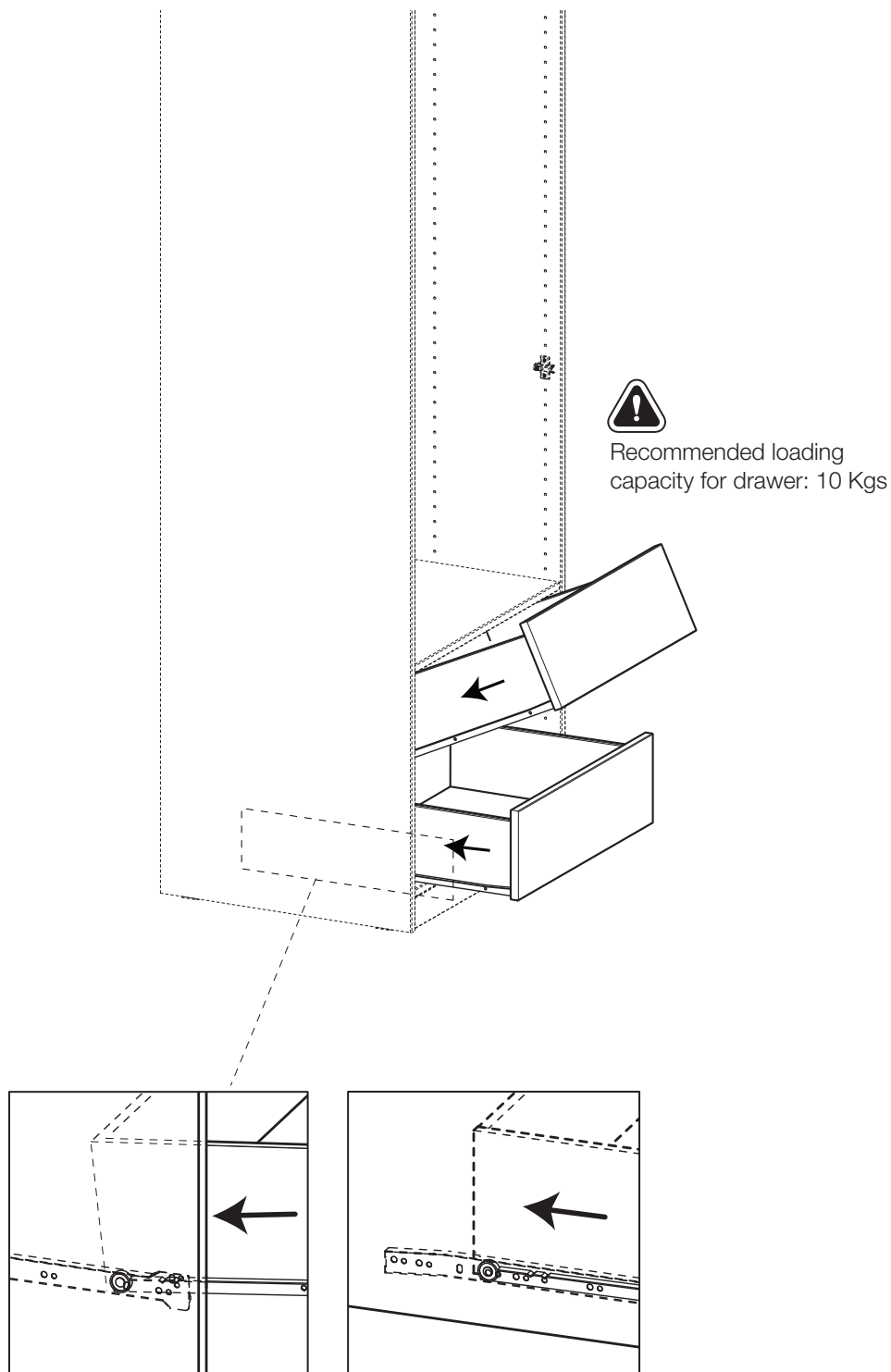
1. Fix 2x runner part (Z2) onto the drawer using 6x screws (F)
repeat for all drawers.
2. Position 2x fixing blocks (F) into the groove of the drawer back, drawer front and screw to fix.
repeat for all drawers.

Step Eight

1. Tilt the drawer as shown.
2. Slide the drawer box along the runner parts until the stop.
Wheels and runner parts have to be correctly matched as shown.



Care and Maintenance

This product has been manufactured using modern manufacturing methods and materials.

To keep your product, looking at its best, we strongly recommend either dusting with a soft cloth, or the use of a damp (not wet) cloth and water containing no more than a 5% soap solution.
Dry with a soft clean cloth.

Aggressive chemicals, such as wax furniture polish, abrasive cleaners, bleach or hypochlorate (chlorine) based cleaners, multi purpose cleaners, dilutes, acetone, alcohol and solvent based liquid product should NOT be used, as may result in damage.

Safety Instructions

Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it.

Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten when necessary.

Please take care when handling or moving the furniture as careless handling may cause damage or injury.

Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly installed. Assembly should be carried out by a competent person. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled furniture.

It is recommended that before moving a heavy object to a new location it is completely dis-assembled to avoid personal injury or damage to the furniture. Please be careful to retain all fittings when doing this.
