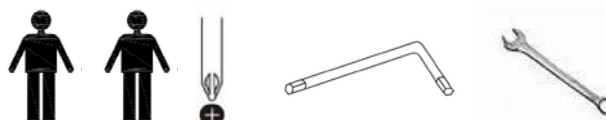

Read this leaflet in full before commencing assembly.

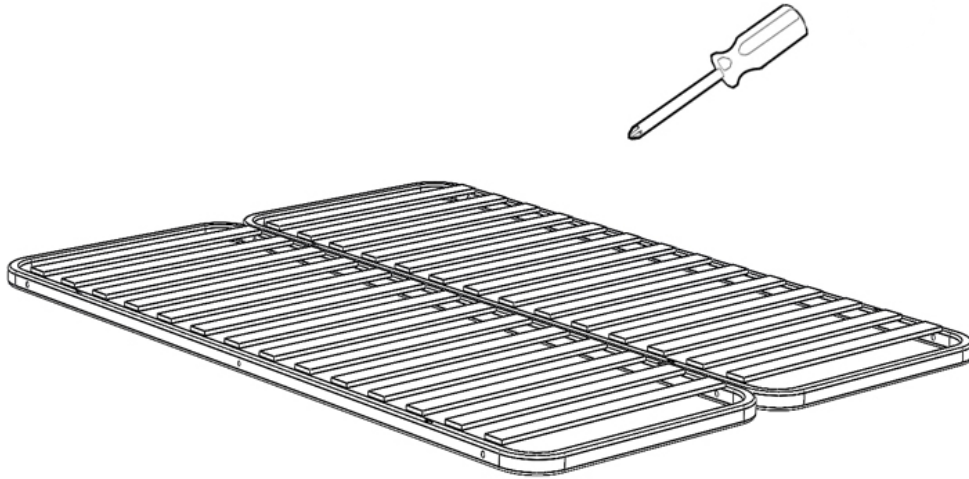

Step by step assembly instructions

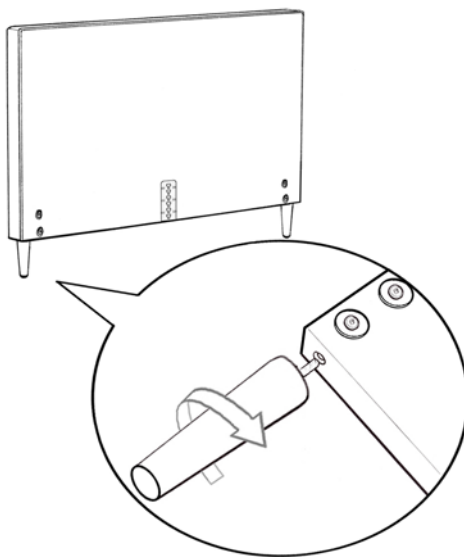
Step One

1. Build the slatted steel bed base following the instructions provided within.



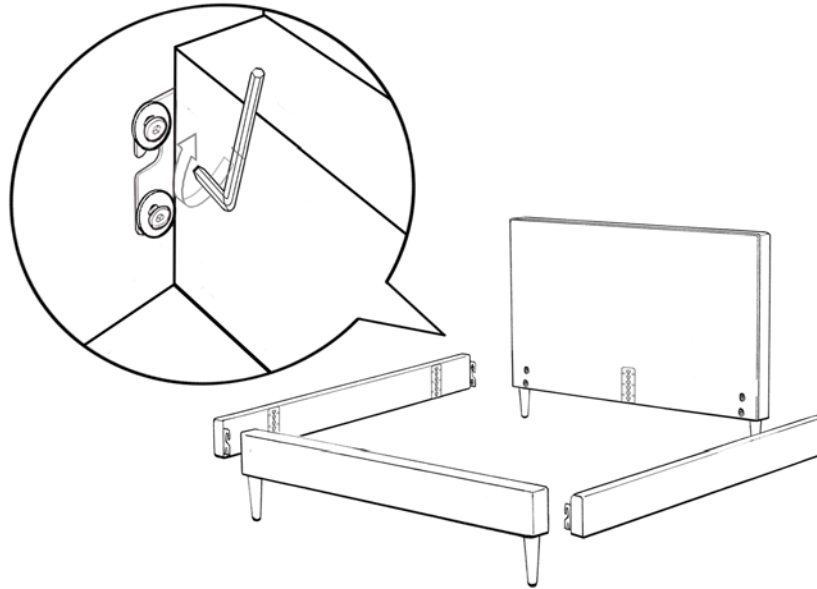
Step Two

1. Packaged with the side panels you will find the bed feet.. Fit these into the threaded hole on the base of the head and footboard by turning clockwise. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.



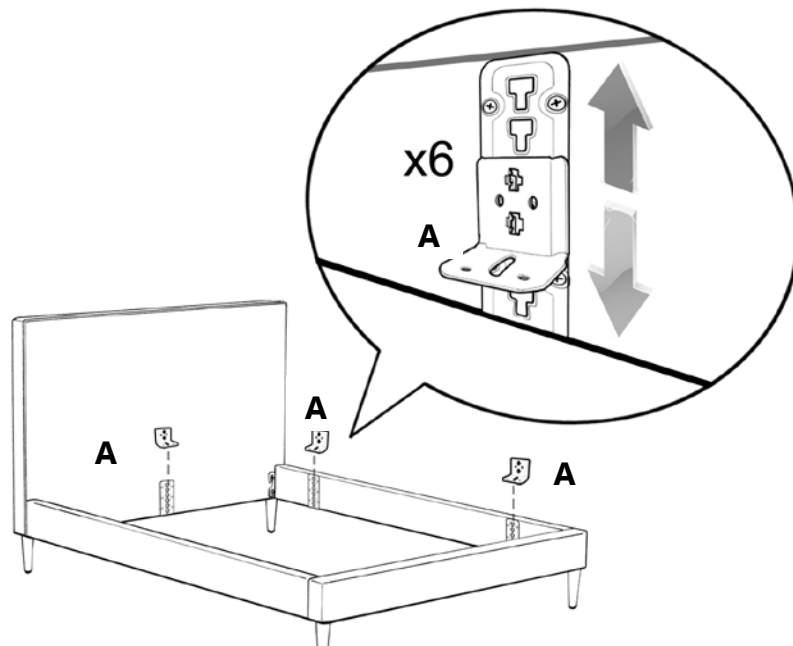
Step Three

1. Lean the headboard against a wall or with the aid of another person, loosen the 4 allen bolts and lift the side panel into place by sliding the corner bracket across and down onto the bolts as shown. Ensure washers sit in front of the bracket.
2. Repeat with the footboard.
3. Using the allen key provided, tighten all 8 bolts evenly. **DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN**



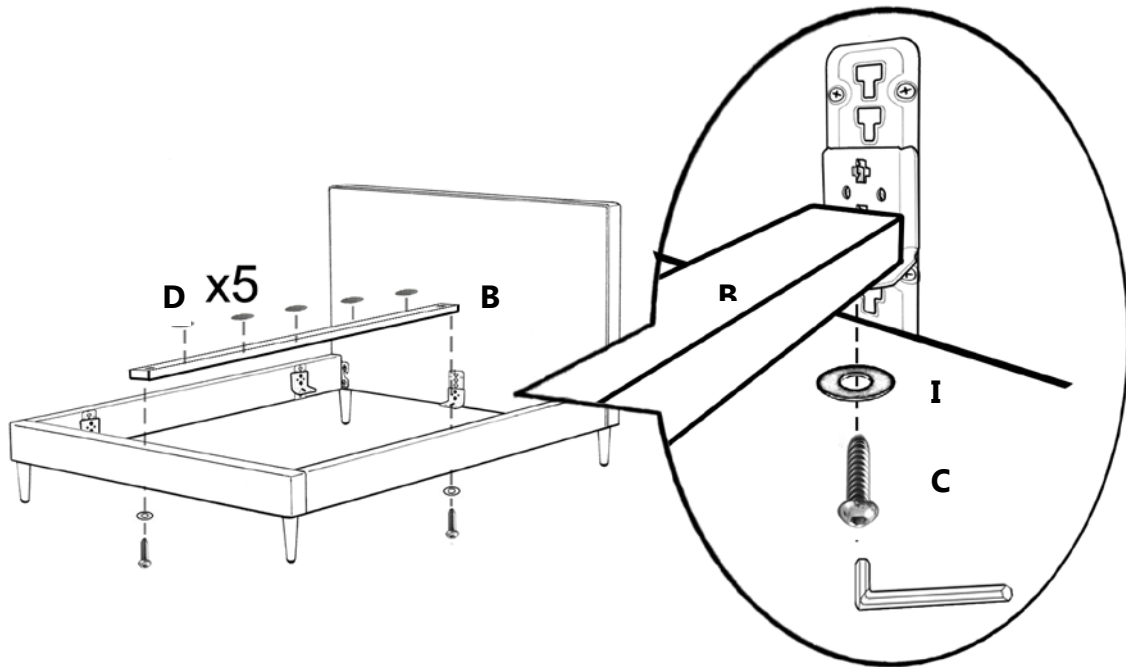
Step 4

1. Take bracket 'A' and slot into the notched steel plates on the head/footboard and side panels by pushing in and down as shown. Select your preferred mattress height using the corresponding slot and ensure that the 4 brackets on the side rails are positioned at the same height. The bracket on the head and foot boards **MUST** be positioned 1 SLOT LOWER than the brackets on the side rails.



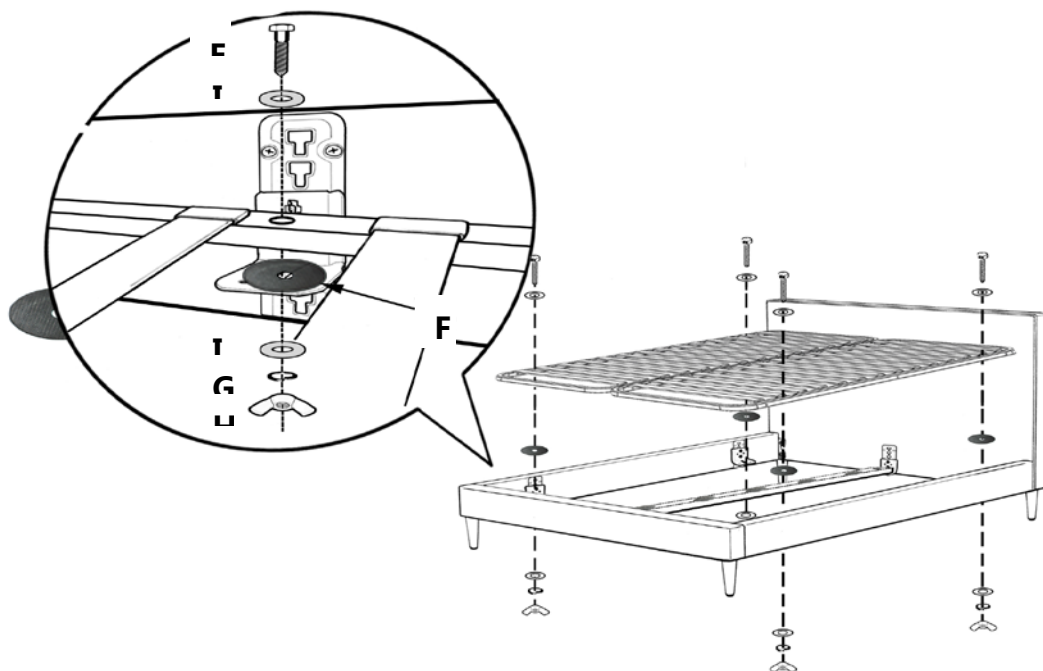
Step 5

1. Take the Centre beam 'B' and lay onto the two brackets 'A' positioned on the head and foot boards. Use the allen keys provided to secure in place from beneath with bolt 'C' and washer 'I' at both ends.
2. Apply 5x sticky back pad 'D', evenly spaced along the length of the centre beam 'B'.



Step 6

1. Place 1x rubber washer 'F' onto each of the 4 brackets 'A' positioned on the side rails and lower the assembled slatted base into the bed frame. Align holes on the steel bed base with the holes on brackets 'A'.
2. Insert bolt 'E' with washer 'I' on top and bottom, followed by washer 'G' and hand tighten with wing nut 'H'.



Care and Maintenance

Wooden Feet

Wood displays different grain patterns depending on which way they cut - for example, the 'medullary ray' which can appear on oak furniture is a mark of good quality timber - these are just characteristics of the natural beauty of the wood. Some furniture is also deliberately aged and rustic.

All timber surfaces will change colour and mellow over time. New furniture will initially vary in shade from items that have been previously purchased.

Metal and Fabric

Protect fabrics from spillage, sunlight and heat. A slightly damp cloth is the best cleaning agent for both materials.

Do not use any abrasive cleaner or harsh detergent as this can damage the surface.

Avoid spilling or dropping crumbs of food with a high fat content on the surface as this can permanently mark the fabric.

Safety Instructions

General warnings:

Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it.

Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.

Please take care when handling or moving the furniture as careless handling may cause damage or injury.

Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly installed. Assembly should be carried out by a competent person. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled furniture.

Specific warnings for heavy items:

It is recommended that before moving heavy objects to a new location they are completely dis-assembled to avoid personal injury or damage to the furniture. Please be careful to retain all fittings when doing this.
