



# Assembly instructions for Georgie Floor Lamp

Thank you for purchasing this Georgie Floor Lamp. Please read the instructions and warnings carefully before use to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product.

## **Warning**

Please read these instructions carefully before commencing any work. Always use the correct type and wattage bulb. Never exceed the wattage stated. When changing the bulb, ensure the product is unplugged and always allow the old bulb to cool down before handling. Dispose of used bulbs carefully. Keep instructions for future reference.

Your standard lamp has been packaged as four parts to prevent damage during transit.

See overleaf for diagram.

Please follow these assembly instructions carefully:

Remove all packaging from the base and the tubes.

- 1) Place base (D) on a firm flat surface.
- 2) Screw tube (B) on to tube (A), then screw on tube (C). Make sure you do not cross the threads and all tubes are fully tightened.
- 3) Fit assembled stem into base and secure in place with grub screws (E), using the allen key provided. Check grub screws are tight. The help of an assistant might be useful.  
\* Note, it may be necessary to loosen the screws first to allow the tube to fit.
- 4) Remove the shade ring (G) from the lampholder, place the shade (F) over the lampholder and refit the shade ring. Tighten to secure the shade in place.
- 6) Fit a suitable 60W ES GLS light bulb or 11W energy saver light bulb. Do not exceed the recommended wattage as this may cause damage to the light fitting.

Your standard lamp is now ready for use.

Switch on using the floor switch.
