













This product takes approximately **45 MINUTES** to assemble with **2 PEOPLE**.

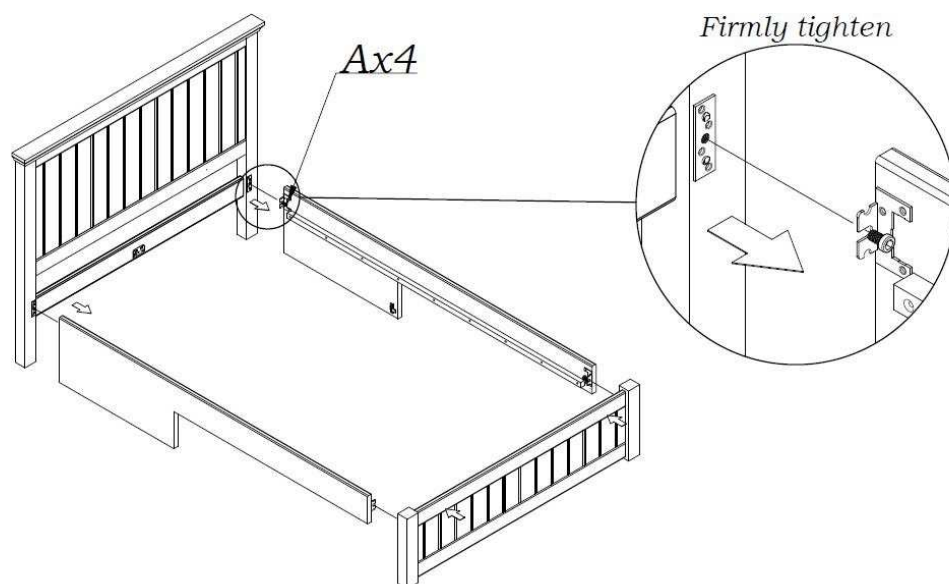

Step by step assembly instructions

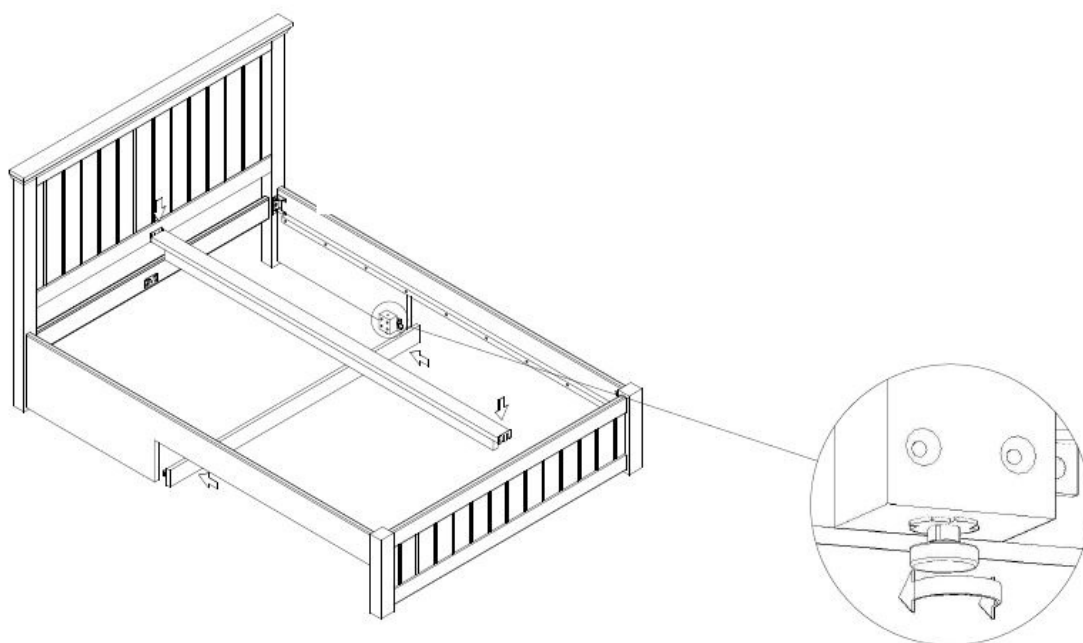
Step One

Firmly tighten 4 x Bolts (A) by hand into the Head End (01) and Foot End (04) as shown (2 into the head end and 2 into the foot end) until they will not go in any further.



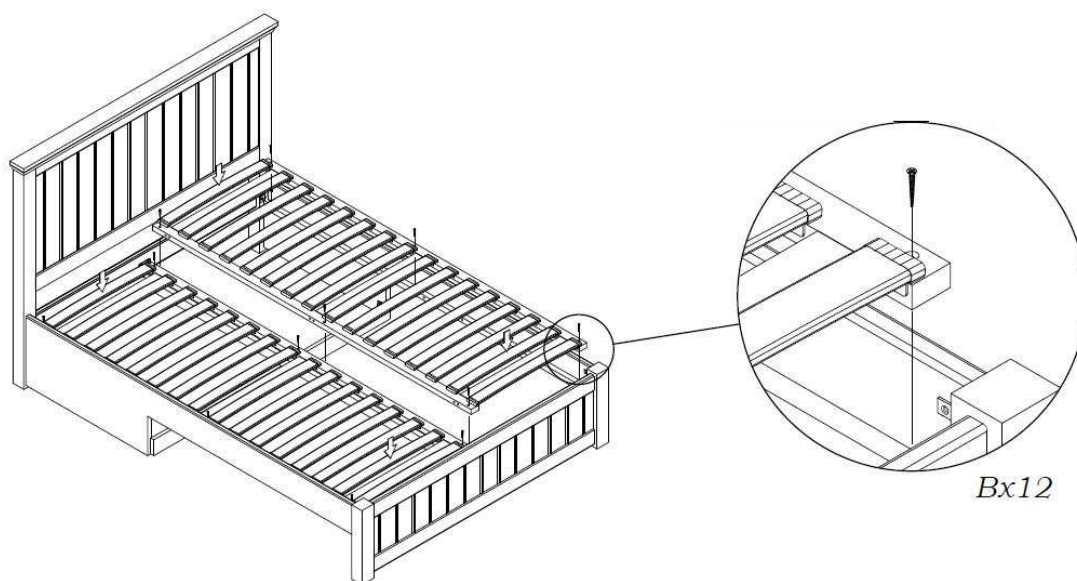
Step Two

Attach the centre support rail (08) onto the support brackets, push firmly downwards to secure in place. Attach the middle support rail (05) onto the support brackets (02) and (03). Push firmly forward to secure in place. Please adjust the side support legs to your floor level.



Step Three

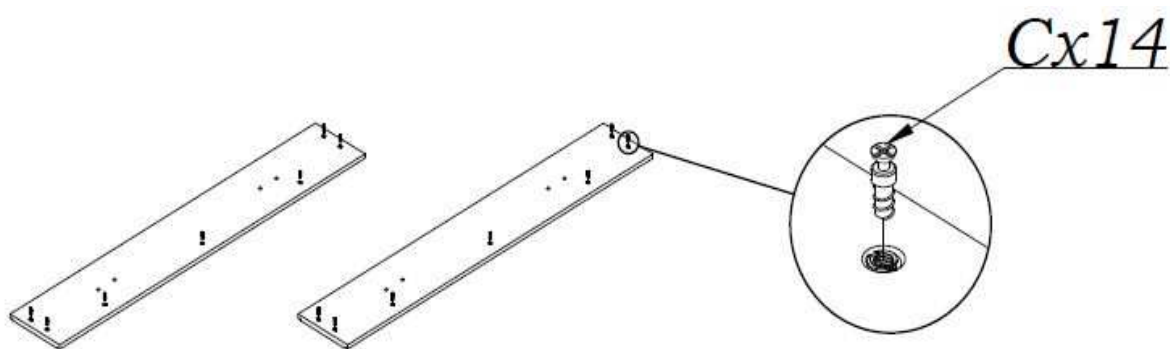
Screw all of the 12 (B) screws into predrilled holes. These screws tighten slats to bedframe.



Step Four

Drawer Fronts

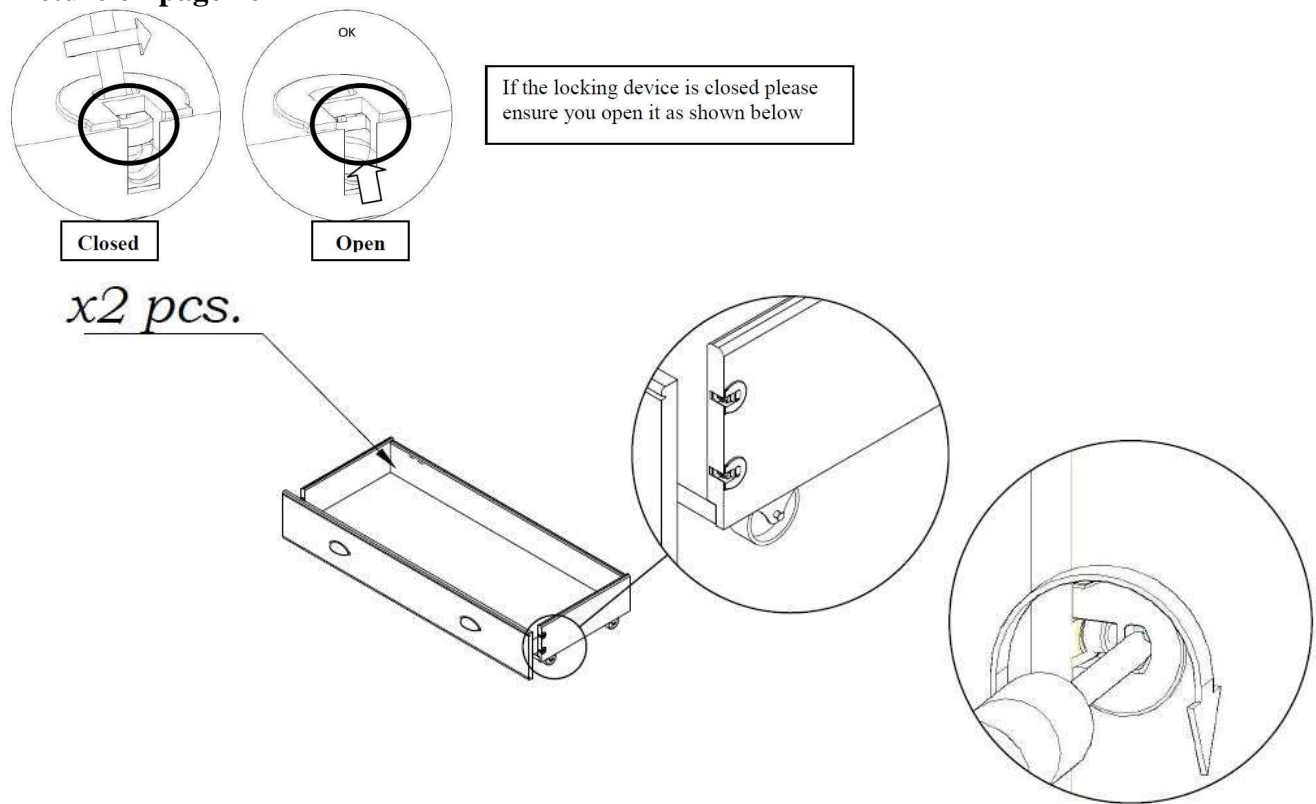
All fittings (C) must be screw into pre fitted cams of drawer fronts (06).



Step Five

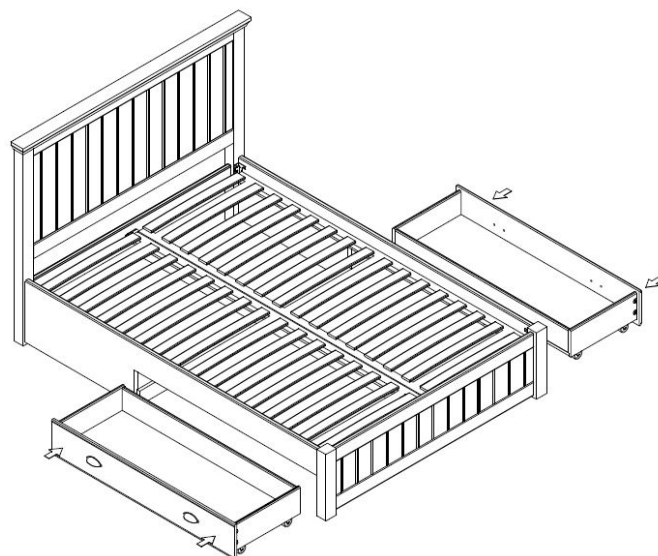
Please attach drawer fronts (06) to drawers as shown per picture. If cams don't lock into place please use screwdriver to adjust them. Tighten the drawer fronts (06) with a screw driver.

Step Six

Gently push the drawers in their place.



Care and Maintenance

The Downton range is a timeless painted bedroom range in either white with metal cup handles or ivory with solid oak tops and metal cup handles. Each piece has been carefully constructed to ensure it will give you years of pleasure. The natural characteristics of oak may include small cracks, knots, blemishes, and grain pattern variations which all add to the natural charm and beauty of this furniture product. Each piece is unique, and for this reason no two pieces within the range will perfectly match, however there will be harmony between all the pieces you may have purchased.

All timber surfaces will change colour and mellow over time. New furniture will initially vary in shade from items that have been previously purchased.

How to care for your furniture

Try to avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight as this may alter the colour and tone of your furniture over time.

Any spillages that do happen should be wiped up immediately with a clean dry lint free cloth to avoid marking the surface of the furniture.

Safety Instructions

General warnings:

Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it. Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary. Please take care when handling or moving the furniture as careless handling may cause damage or injury.

Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly installed. Assembly should be carried out by a competent person. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled furniture.

Specific warnings for heavy items:

It is recommended that before moving heavy objects to a new location they are completely disassembled to avoid personal injury or damage to the furniture. Please be careful to retain all fittings when doing this.
