Step by step assembly instructions

Step one

- I. Locate the side rails brackets (C) onto the headboard brackets (A).
- 2. Secure using four 13mm Bolts (3) and the 13mm spanner (4).








The holes in the siderails should be facing upwards.

Step two

 $I.\,Locate\;the\;side\;rails\;brackets\;(C)\;onto\;the\;footboard\;brackets\;(B).$


2. Secure using four 13mm Bolts (3) and the 13mm spanner (4).





Step three

Locate the centre rail (D) into the headboard and footboard brackets.




Please note

The holes in the centre rail should be facing upwards.


Step four

- 1. Push fit two plastic caps (5) onto either end of a slat (E).
- 2. Push fit the slat (E) into the pre-drilled pilot holes. Please note that the slat may need to be pushed flat to ease installation. It may also require a light tap with a soft hammer to secure the plastic end caps into the holes.




Step five

Repeat step four with the remaining slats (E) and slat caps (5).




Step six

- $\label{eq:local_problem} I.\, Push \ fit \ four \ dowels \ (I) \ into \ the \ bedside \ top \ panel \ (F).$
- 2. Push fit four dowels (1) into the bedside bottom panel (G).




Step seven

- I. Locate the bedside front attachment panel (H) and bedside back panel (I) onto the protruding dowels from the bedside top panel (F) and bedside bottom panel (G).
- 2. Secure using twelve 25mm CSK screws and a crosshead screwdriver.




Step eight

Push fit two dowels (I) into the bedside front attachment panel (H).




Step nine

- I. Locate the bedside front panel (J) onto the protruding dowels.
- 2. Secure using four 25mm CSK screws.
- 3. Repeat steps 6, 7, 8 and 9 to the other bedside.




Step ten

- 1. Carefully lift the front of the bedside upwards, ensuring the bedside back panel can clear under the side rail.
- 2. Using the castors push the bedside under the side rails until the back panel has cleared the side rail.
- 3. Carefully lower the front of bedside downwards.
- 4. Push the bedside against the side rails.
- 5. Repeat the procedure to the other bedside.




Step eleven

Push fit eight dowels (1) into two drawer side panels (M).




Step twelve

- I. Locate the protruding dowels from the drawer side panels (M) in to the drawer box back panel (L).
- 2. Secure using four 25csk screws (2) and a crosshead screwdriver through the rear of the drawer box back panel (L).
- 3. Locate one drawer base panel (P) through the grooves lines.




Step thirteen

- I. Locate one drawer front attachment panel (K) onto the protruding dowels at the same time as locating the exposed drawer base panel into the groove line.
- 2. Secure using four 25mm CSK screws and a crosshead screwdriver.
- 3. Push fit two dowels (1) into the two pre-drilled on the drawer front attachment panel (K).




Step fourteen

- I. Locate one drawer front (O) onto the two protruding dowels.
- 2. Secure using four 25mm CSK screws (2) and a crosshead screwdriver.



Step fifteen


- I. Carefully the turn the drawer upside down.
- 2. Locate two castor rails (N) into the notes on the underside of the bedside.
- 3. Secure each castor rail (N) with four 25mm CSK screws (2) and a crosshead screwdriver.
- 4. Carefully turn the bedside the correct way up.



Step sixteen

- I. Carefully lift the front of the drawer upwards, ensuring the drawer back panel can clear under the side rail.
- 2. Using the castors push the drawer under the side rails until the back panel has cleared the side rail.
- 3. Carefully lower the front of drawer downwards.
- 4. Push the drawer against the side rails.
- 5. Repeat the procedure to the other four drawers.
- 6. Removal of the drawer is the reversal of step 16.

The assembly is now complete.



Care and Maintenance

This product should be, for general cleaning, dusted weekly with a soft lint free cloth.

Do not use furniture polish. Any spills should be removed immediately with a soft clean cloth.

Do not rub or scrub the surface when cleaning.

Do not use abrasive cleaning products or those containing silicone.

Our furniture will endure most temperatures in the home but it is best to avoid placing furniture next to heat sources such as radiators or fires. Be particularly careful with solid wood as the lack of humidity caused by central heating can cause damage such as warping.

Regularly check all fixings and re-tighten as necessary.

Never drag furniture when moving it; always lift it.

Important Safety Note

Please make sure that the side rails and centre rail brackets are securely fixed to the headboard and footboard before use.

The maximum weight for each under bed storage bedside and drawer is 20kgs.

DO NOT EXCEED THIS WEIGHT

No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by inadequate fixing or use without fixing.
