Read this leaflet in full before commencing assembly.

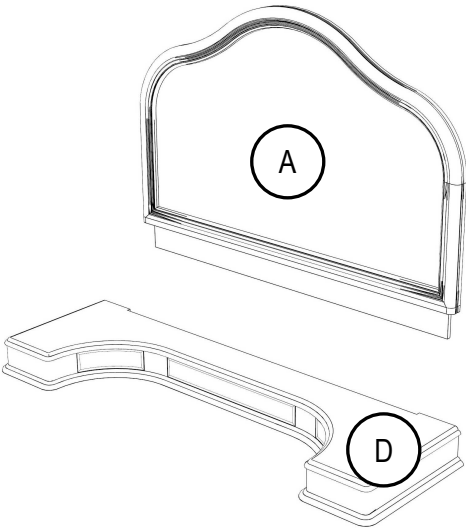

Step by step assembly instructions

Step One

Place the mirror section (A) to the base of the unit (D) with the help of another person.



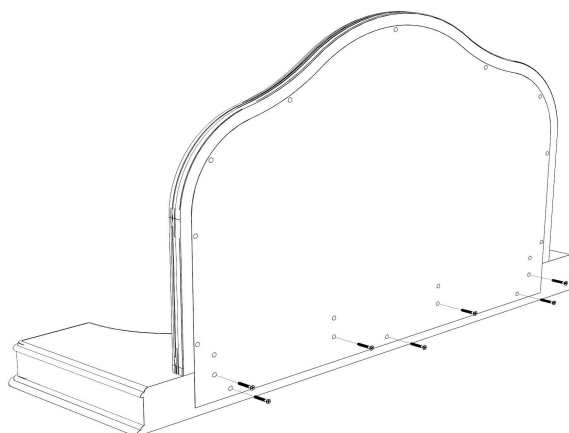
Step Two

Using a cross headed screwdriver attach the mirror (A) to the base unit (D) using the x7 screws provided (B)

If you have purchased the Rose dressing table, please follow the below instructions

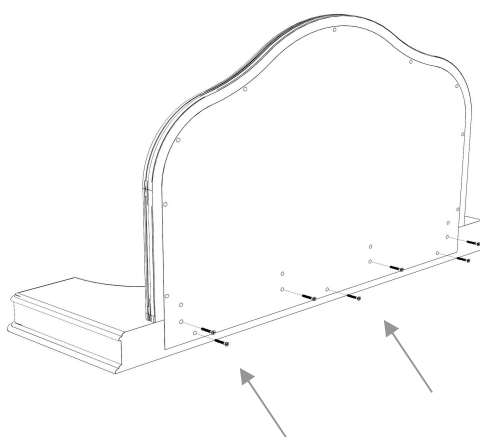

Place the T Section (E) onto the back of the dressing mirror (A) with the screws provided (C)

Care and Maintenance

The John Lewis Rose bedroom collection is crafted from solid Birch and Birch veneers and then hand finished with several coats of paint. Each piece is then individually distressed. This is achieved by gently rubbing by hand the top layers of finish to get to the initial coats of paint to create an authentic aged appearance. Some distressing will be black and some will be clear, but this is a natural characteristic of the effect.

Every item is unique in the way it is finished and the cracks and rubs in the paint finish are an integral part of the design. All carving on the Rose range is done by hand by skilled craftsmen that are specifically trained. The signature carved Roses take 4 hours apiece to produce.

Safety Instructions

General warnings:

Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it. Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary. Please take care when handling or moving the furniture as careless handling may cause damage or injury.

Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly installed. Assembly should be carried out by a competent person. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled furniture.

Specific warnings for heavy items:

It is recommended that before moving heavy objects to a new location they are completely disassembled to avoid personal injury or damage to the furniture. Please be careful to retain all fittings when doing this.
