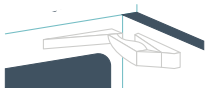


INSTALLATION CHECKLIST: FRIDGE FREEZERS

Fixed hinge



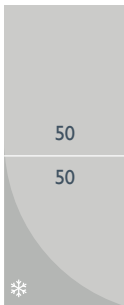
Attaches the appliance door directly to the cabinet door

Sliding hinge



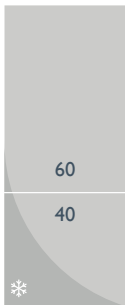
Glides along the back of the cabinet door

50/50



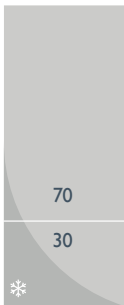
Equally split doors

60/40



Both of these usually fit the same doors, but a 70/30 model is likely to need a plinth. This must already be in place to align the door split

Within 1 metre of your appliance location

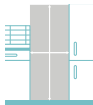
