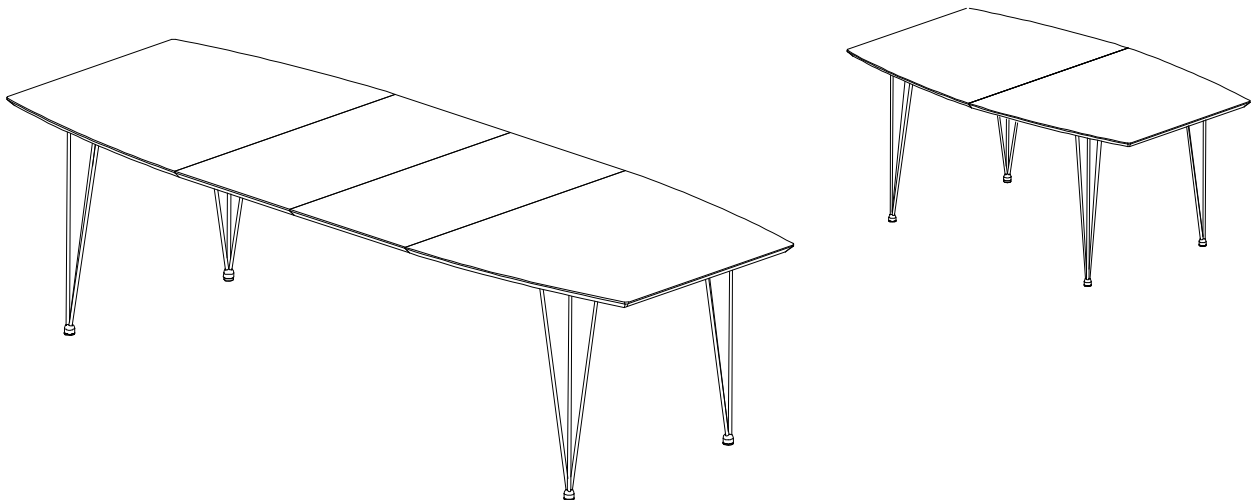







This product is **HEAVY**, it should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use. **TAKE CARE WHEN LIFTING** to avoid personal injury and (or) damage to the product.

This product takes approximately **15 MINUTES** to assemble with **2 PEOPLE**.

The fittings pack contains **SMALL ITEMS** which should be **KEPT AWAY FROM YOUNG CHILDREN**.

Read this leaflet in full before commencing assembly.

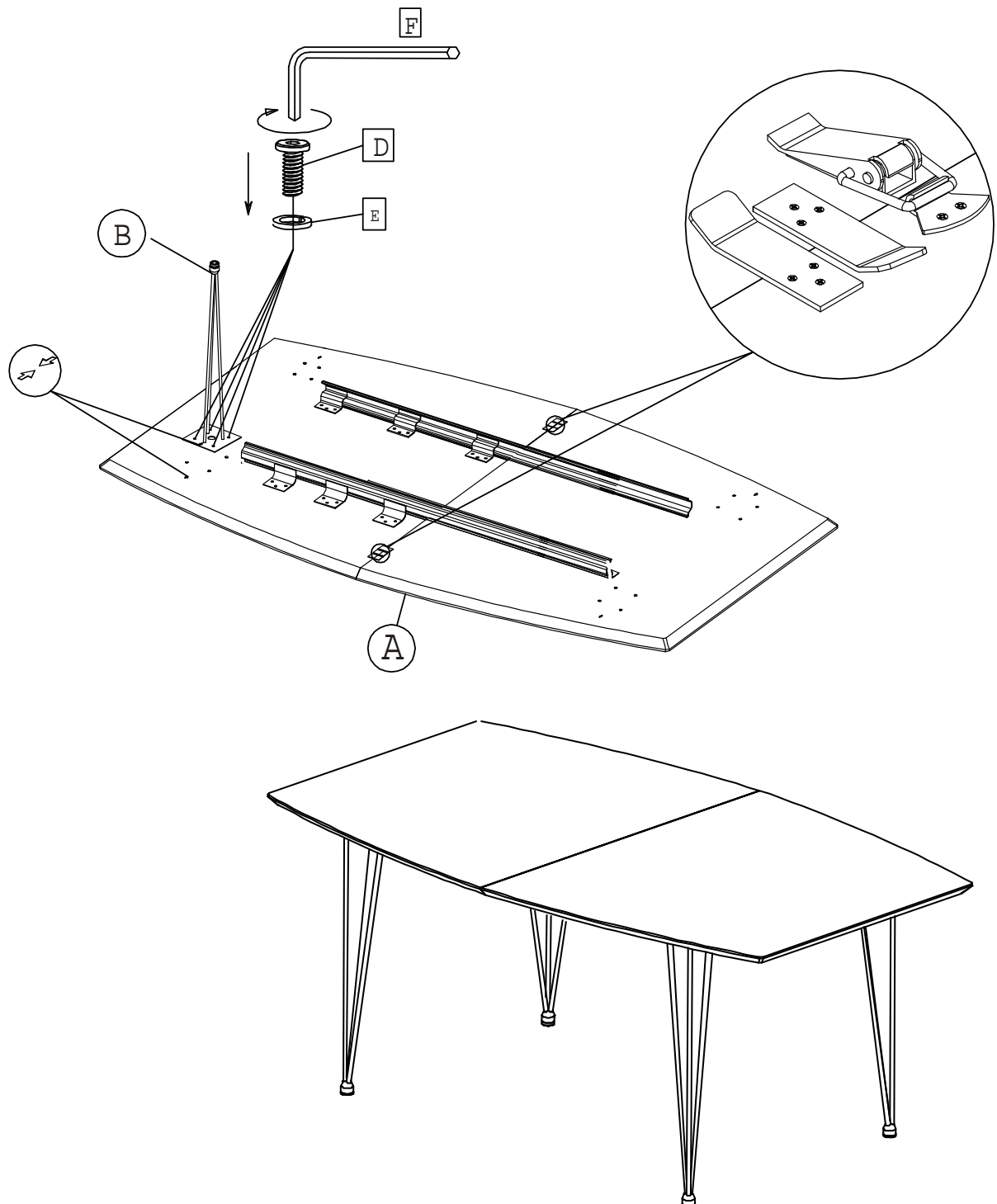

Step by step assembly instructions

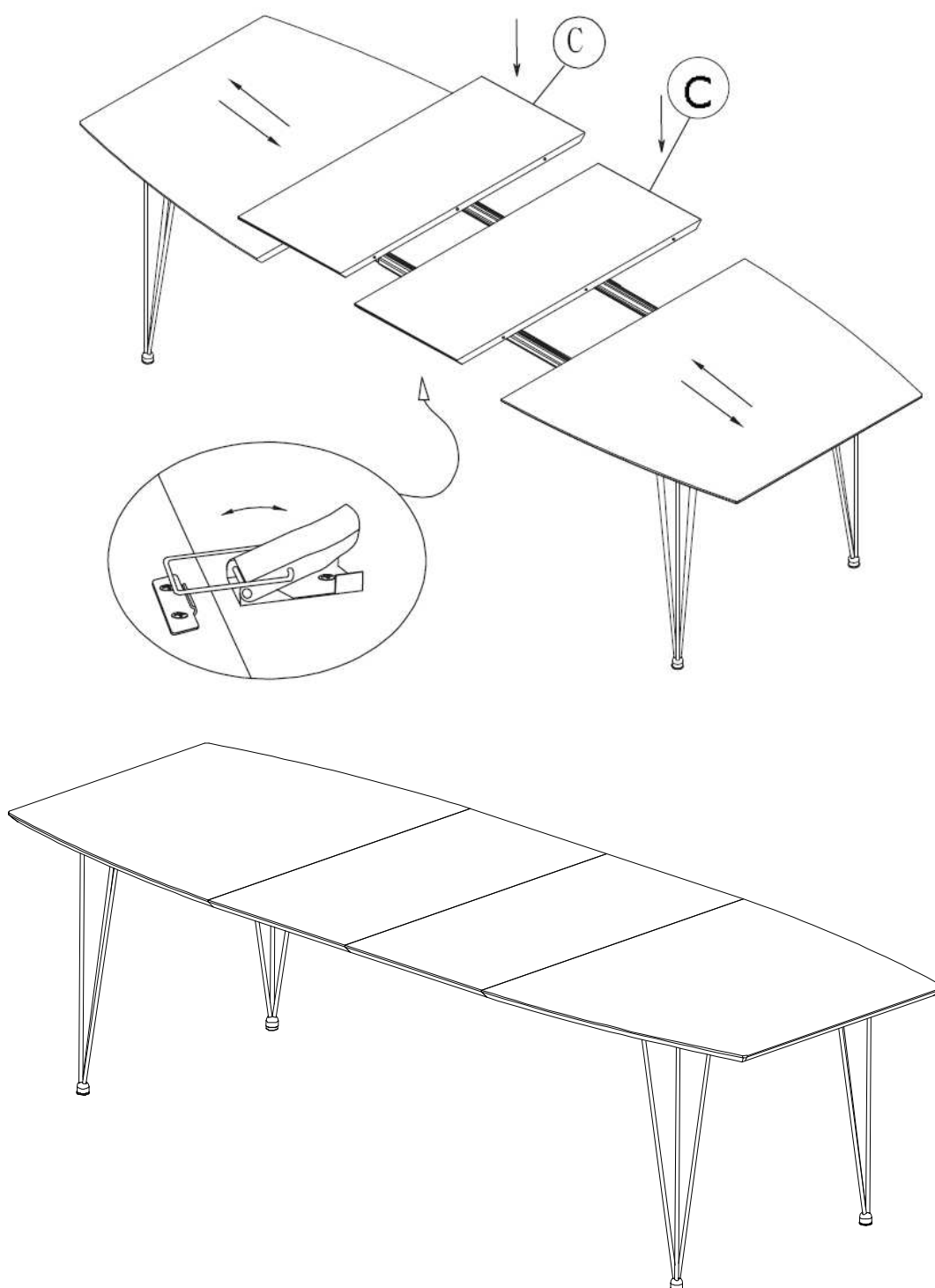
Step One

1. Lay a protective cloth onto the floor before commencing assembly. **Place** the table top (A) upside down onto cloth.
2. **Make sure the table top is locked together securely as shown.**
3. **Place each leg** onto the marked underside of the table top as shown.
4. **Secure each leg using 1 x washer (E) and 1 x bolt (D) by inserting through the pre drilled leg holes into the underside of the table top**
5. **Using allen key, screw and tighten all 4 bolts and washers.**
6. **Once all four legs are secured onto table, carefully turn the table to an upright position. By lifting and taking care not to pivot on the legs.**



Step Two

1. To extend the table, open both locks.
2. Carefully pull apart the table leaves to their maximum.
3. Lift the provided extension leaves over the top of the table and locate them between the table ends . Take care not to slide leaves over surface of table as this may scratch the surface.
4. Finally, push each end of the table towards the middle, taking care to ensure pins along edge of each leaf locate into adjoining leaf holes, until fully closed.
5. Close and secure each of the locks.
6. The table assembly now is complete.
7. To remove leaves, please reverse unstructions.



Care and Maintenance

The table should be cleaned with a dry or damp soft cloth, do not use anything abrasive as this may damage the surface of the product.

Protect surfaces from hot items, scratches and marks by using mats and coasters.

Do not use the table top as a chopping surface.

Safety Instructions

Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it.

Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.

Please take care when handling or moving the furniture as careless handling may cause damage or injury.

Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly installed. Assembly should be carried out by a competent person. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled furniture.

It is recommended that before moving heavy objects to a new location they are completely dis-assembled to avoid personal injury or damage to the furniture. Please be careful to retain all fittings when doing this.
