Wood Furniture

Wood is a natural material which reacts to weather conditions. Depending on weather type, the wood can swell or dry resulting in crack formation. The risk can be minimised by cleaning and/or treating the furniture with oil at regular intervals and keeping it clean and dry.

Care and Cleaning

Remove dust regularly with a clean dry cloth. Use pads, mats and coasters under plates, glasses, cups, vases etc to protect them from scratches, spills, stains and heat damage. Wipe spills immediately to prevent staining. Natural Acacia, Teak oiled finish: Your new outdoor furniture should be treated with oil directly after purchase and after that at regular intervals or at least once a year.

Furniture that has been outdoors for some time should be cleaned before being re-oiled. Wash/scrub with water and a mild cleaner. Rinse and leave to dry before applying a new coat of oil.

Acacia Furniture: The polyurethane finish is a liquid resin with a durable finish which is more resistant to spills and does not need as much protection. Dust regularly with a soft dry cloth and wipe dry. When required wipe with a moist (not wet) cloth. This will remove fingerprints and light dirt. When dirt or grime have built up clean with and dampened cloth and mild cleaner. Rinse and allow to air dry.
