
Product assembly

Sun sail grey 82011808

Step 1

Parts, fittings and tools

Measure and clean the area where the sun sail is to be installed, leave an allowance of 1.5-2ft between the fixing point and the sun sail. The tension at each corner should be300-500N;



Step 2

Parts, fittings, and tools











- 1. Fix pad eye to the area where the sun sail is to be installed.
- 2. Connect the sun sail (1) with the pad eye(D) by the turnbuckle(C) or the snap hook(B) or both based on actual needs.

You can also fix the sun sail by the rope (A) if applicable.

3. Repeat for other 2 corners, choose hyperbolic style with 2 sides higher than other, allow heavy rain to run off and also makes your shade sail looks more attractive.





Care guide

Care and maintenance

Fold the sunshade sail in adverse weather conditions (strong winds, rain, frost, snow, etc.) Do not change the structure of the sail.

Wipe clean only, do not use any sponge; Never use abrasive chemicals or cleaning agents. Rinse thoroughly and allow to dry.

Safety instructions

Do not hang any objects on the sunshade sail.

Stay away from fire or any glowing objects (candles, barbecues...)

No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled parasol bases.

Sun sail should not be used in high winds or during inclement weather.

Check if the edges of 3 are correctly fixed.

Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.
