




# Assembly

Refer to drawing overleaf. Carefully unpack the carton, making sure all the parts are present before assembly.



Step I

See Fig. 1. Holding on to the ends of the shade, pull the shade into a spherical shape.




# Step 2

Starting with the leading edge of the shade (point 2), using the numbering and arrow direction in Figure 2 as a reference, weave one side of the shade into the other, working your way to the inside edge of the shade. Repeat this action until all slots of the shade are located into each other.

### Step 3

Flip the shade over, and repeat Step 2 until the final form is achieved.



### Step 4

See Fig. 3 Carefully open top of shade and place gimbal insert inside. Locate tabs 'A' of gimbal and insert into shade slots 'B', as shown at point 2.

# Step 5

Locate the shade over the lampholder and secure in place with the shade ring. Fit the recommended bulb. Your pendant shade is now ready for use.

# **Care instructions**

We recommend cleaning with a soft dry cloth. Do not use abrasive materials as these will damage the finish.
