



Select the mains power outlet you wish to connect the plug to and hold the product in place on the wall, marking the fixing hole positions. Check there are no mains cables or pipes beneath the wall. Drill the holes and fit the supplied wall plugs (1) - which are suitable for masonry only. This product is not suitable for use in children's bedrooms.

Fix the product to the wall using the supplied screws (2).

### Step 4

To keep the cable tidy, this product is supplied with two metal retaining clips. Decide on the cable position. Using the retaining clips as a template mark and drill the position of the fixing holes. Be careful not to damage any wiring or pipes. Place the clips around the cable and fix in place using the supplied fixing screws (4). IMPORTANT: Children can become entangled in loose cable. Ensure excessive loops of cable are secured against the wall using the fittings supplied. Do not use this product in children's bedrooms.


