



RULES

CONTENTS:

80 cards

SET-UP:

The game is for two or more players. Place the pack in the centre of the table.

HOW TO PLAY:

The first player takes the top card from the pack, turns it over and reads the category aloud. He is allowed a few seconds to think, then must name an item in the category. For example, if the category is 'body parts', he could say 'mouth'.

Play then proceeds in a clockwise direction, with the player to the first player's left naming a different item in the same category and so on. Each player is allowed about three seconds of thinking time, and to keep this fair the players can clap, click their fingers or tap out three beats between the answers, as in: 1 – 2 - 3 – ITEM, with the item being named on every fourth beat.

A player is not permitted to:

- name an item that isn't in the category;
- hesitate or take too long to name an item;
- repeat an item that has already been named in the round.

The game is paused each time a player fails to correctly name an item. He is then eliminated from the round, and play continues until there is only one player left, who wins the card.

The next player then picks up a card from the pack, reads out the category and names an item, and play continues as before.

Disagreement about the validity of a categorisation must be resolved by good-natured discussion...

TO WIN THE GAME:

The first player to win three cards is the winner.
