

Mark in the ceiling the position of the bracket holes. Drill in these points ensuring any wire of the existing household wiring could be damaged. Insert the wall plugs, place the bracket over them and screw up the bolts.
				2	Canopy D-a	Having identified the household wiring from your existing light fitting, connect to the connection block inside. Ensure that : You have correctly identified the house wires. The connections are tight. No loose strands have been left out of the connection block.
