Cleaning and maintenance should not be carried out by children.


- Children must not play with the appliance.

To get started	 Connect to the mains with the supplied plug. The time and date will be visible when there is a mains connection. Press the power button to turn on (and off). The back up function will ensure your chosen settings remain saved. The time will not be displayed.
For DAB	 The first time you turn on the radio, it will complete an automatic scan for all available DAB stations. Use the arrow keys to navigate between stations. Should you wish to perform a full scan, long press "Select/Menu" and navigate to "Full Scan". Short press "Select/Menu" to confirm.
For FM	 Short press "Mode" to switch to FM mode. Use the arrow keys to find the correct FM frequency. Long press for an auto-scan or short press for fine adjustment.
For Bluetooth	 Short press "Mode" to switch to Bluetooth mode. To connect, search on your phone, tablet or other device for "Prelude". Long press "Mode" to disconnect your Bluetooth device.
Aux-in	 Aux mode plays audio from an external source plugged into the 3.5mm aux-in jack. Short press "Mode" to switch to aux mode. Plug your phone, tablet or other audio device into the aux-in 3.5mm stereo socket at the back of your Prelude. Adjust the volume of the Prelude (and, if necessary, the audio device) as required.
Setting the dual alarm	 Short press "Alarm 1" or "Alarm 2" to turn the function on or off. Long Press "Alarm 1" or "Alarm 2" to enter the set-up menu. Use arrow keys and "Select/Menu" buttons to complete an alarm set-up by frequency, time, type and volume.
Snooze or stop a sounding alarm	 Press "Snooze" to pause a sounding alarm. Press "Alarm 1" or "Alarm 2" to stop a sounding alarm.

Presets

Prelude has 30 presets.

Presets 1-4 have dedicated physical buttons

Presets 5-30 are accessed using the 5+ preset button and the digital preset menu.

Using presets 1-4

To save a preset, tune into your preferred station on DAB or FM and long press preset button 1, 2, 3 or 4.

The number of the presets and the word 'STORED' will appear on the digital display.

To recall a preset, short press button 1, 2,3 or 4 and the stored station will play.

Using presets 5-30

To save a preset, tune in you preferred station on DAB or FM and long press preset button 5+, this brings up the digital preset menu. By using the PREVIOUS/NEXT navigation buttons you can navigate to any of the 5-30 presets, use the SELECT button to save the current station to your chosen preset.

To recall a preset, short press button 5+ to bring up the digital preset menu, by using the PREVIOUS/NEXT navigation buttons you can navigate to any of the 5-30 presets, use the SELECT button to select and play your chosen preset.

Accessing menu options Language

- Long press "Select/Menu" and use the arrow keys to navigate to Language.
- 2 Short press "Select/Menu" to access the set-up menu.
- 3 Use the arrow keys to choose either English, German, Norwegian or French. Short press "Select/Menu" to confirm your language choice.

Clock/Date setup	1 2 3 4 5	Long press "Select/Menu" and use the arrow keys to navigate to "Clock/Date Setup". Short press "Select/Menu" to access the set-up menu. Use the arrow keys to choose between "Radio" or "Manual", then short press "Select/Menu" to confirm. ("Radio" will set the time from the radio frequency and will thus auto-adjust for daylight savings time.) Choose between 12hr or 24hr time format. Short press "Select/Menu" to confirm. Choose between dd-mm-yy or mm-dd-yy date format. Short press "Select/Menu" to confirm.
Countdown timer	1 2 3	Long press "Select/Menu" and use the arrow keys to navigate to "Countdown Timer". Short press "Select/Menu" to access the set-up menu. Use the arrow keys to select Off/On, followed by the desired time (in hours, minutes and seconds). Short press "Select/Menu" to start the countdown timer.
Backlight	1 2 3	The screen will auto-dim by default, based on ambient light. To set the screen to a particular brightness level, long press "Select/Menu" and navigate to "Backlight". Screen brightness can be set at levels from 1 to 5 or on auto mode. Short press "Select/Menu" to confirm.
Setting the sleep timer	1 2 3	Long press "Select/Menu" and use the arrow keys to navigate to "Sleep". Short press "Select/Menu" to access the set-up menu. Use the arrow keys to choose your duration, then short press "Select/Menu" to confirm.
Adjust the EQ (sound equalisation)	1 2 3	To adjust the sound, long press "Select/Menu". Navigate to "EQ Setup" and short press "Select/Menu" to gain access to sound level adjustments. Set the EQ to a genre preset or manually adjust the bass and treble.
Factory reset	1 2 3	Long press "Select/Menu" and use arrow keys to navigate to "Reset". Short press "Select/Menu" to access the set-up menu. To perform a factory reset, use the arrow keys to choose "Yes". Short press "Select/Menu" to confirm.

Care instructions

Do not get the device wet. Avoid using harsh chemical cleaners. Wipe with a soft, damp cloth.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Cause	Solution
I can't find the station I want to listen to.	The station may not broadcast in your local area. There may be local interference.	Check the station is available in your area (if DAB use getdigitalradio.com), extend the cable antenna for best reception, perform a full scan.
I can't connect via Bluetooth.	Bluetooth mode is not selected. Another device is already connected.	Ensure Bluetooth mode is selected on Prelude and on your device. Long press "Mode" to discon- nect any other devices.
The screen is too bright.	The menu settings need to be adjusted or auto-dim turned off.	Manually set the brightness to a lower level or, if using auto-dim, avoid bright lights shining on the screen.
