

2 SLICE TOASTER INSTRUCTION MANUAL



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Important safety information

Thank you for purchasing this toaster.

Please read the instructions and warnings carefully to ensure a long life for your product and safe usage. This instruction leaflet must be retained with the product for future reference. These warnings have been provided in the interest of safety. You MUST read them carefully before using the appliance.

This product is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, unless they are properly supervised or given instructions concerning the safe use of the item by a person responsible for their wellbeing. Children must not play with the appliance. Cleaning and maintenance should not be carried out by children.

- Do not immerse the cord, plug, or any part of the toaster in water or other liquids.
- Unplug from the mains when not in use, when removing or attaching accessories and before cleaning any part of the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug. Should the item malfunction, or if it is damaged in any manner, please stop using it and return it to your nearest John Lewis branch. Do not attempt to repair it yourself. Do not modify the appliance's plug.
- Do not let the power cord overhang the edge of the surface on which it stands, or touch anything hot.
- When unplugging the device, hold the plug itself, not the power cord.
- Do not use the appliance for any purpose other than its intended use.
- This appliance is for indoor use only. Do not use it outdoors.
- For household and light commercial use only.
- Do not use accessories or attachments that are not recommended by the manufacturer.
- Allow the toaster to cool before cleaning or storing it. To clean it, wipe it down with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not insert metal foil or utensils into the toaster as this can cause a fire or electric shock.

- Do not place the toaster beneath curtains or other flammable materials.
- Do not place the toaster on or near a hot surface or appliance.
- Do not use in conjunction with an external timer or remote-control system.
- The outer surface may get hot when the appliance is operating




WARNING: Polythene bags over the product or within packaging may be dangerous. To avoid the risk of suffocation, please keep away from pets, babies and children.

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Your toaster - diagram

- 2 Crumb tray handle
- 3 Crumb tray

- 5 Upper cover plate
- 6 Carraige handle
- 7 Cancel
- 8 Reheat
- 9 Defrost
- 10 Power cord
- 11 Knob



Toaster safety

- 1 Remove all packaging prior to toasting.
- 2 If the toaster starts to smoke, Press the 'Cancel' button to stop toasting immediately.
- 3 Only use the toaster for dry bread. Do not butter bread before
- 4 Never attempt to dislodge bread trapped in the slots without unplugging the toaster first. Remove bread carefully.

Before first use

The toaster may emit a metallic odour the first time it is used. This is normal and will not continue. Run the toaster once or twice and allow it to cool again before using it to toast bread.

Using your toaster




Diagram 1



- 1 Plug the power cord into the outlet.
- 2 Set the colour control dial to your desired toast colour. There are seven settings, from the lightest to the darkest level of toasting (see Diagram 1). To achieve a golden colour, set the dial in the middle.



Note: Toasting a single slice will require a lower setting than two slices. If you are using the toaster more than once continuously, later slices will toast more quickly as the device warms up.

- 3 Press down the carriage handle until it latches in place. The 'Cancel' light will come on and the appliance will begin toasting. Note: The carriage handle can only be latched when the appliance is plugged in.
- 4 Once the bread has toasted according to your chosen setting, the carriage handle will pop up (see Diagram 2). You can press the 'Cancel' button at any time to stop toasting but do not attempt to lift the carriage handle to end the process.
- 5 To toast frozen bread, first press the 'Defrost' button, then set the colour dial to your desired level.
- 6 To toast only one side of a slice of bread, set the colour level, then press the 'Reheat' button. The indicator light will come on and the toasting process will continue as usual.
- 7 To ensure a uniform bread colour, wait 30 seconds before toasting again so that the colour control can reset.

Cleaning and maintenance

- 1 Before cleaning, unplug the toaster and let it cool down completely.
 - 2 Wipe the outside with a soft, damp cloth. Never use metal polish.
 - 3 Pull out the crumb tray at the bottom of toaster and empty it. If the toaster is used frequently, empty the tray at least once a week. Make sure the crumb tray is back in place before using the toaster again.
 - 4 When not in use or when the appliance is in storage, the power cord may be wound under the bottom of the toaster.
