

Honeycomb fabrics are easy to clean. Simply soak the honeycomb fabric in approx. 30 °C water with a mild detergent.

Rinse the fabric well and compress the cells together to push water out of the blind. The blind should not drip anymore. The blind must be hung moist and has to dry closed. During the drying process, open and close the blind several times to prevent cells sticking together.

Do not iron the blind!

Metallized and black-out coated fabrics are not washable. These fabrics can be cleaned carefully with a moist cloth but do not rub! We recommend cleaning by an appropriate specialist.

Please note:

Do not clean windows with any chemical products which make direct or indirect contact with the blind. Condensation spots can arise when there is reduced ventilation.

We do not take responsibility for any fabric damages caused by cleaning the material or insect excrements.

Honeycomb fabrics are not designed for outdoor use, therefore we cannot give any guarantee on fabrics placed in an open or partly glassed roof.
