In 1869 Frederick Parker created the business that was to become Parker Knoll from his father's factory in Bracklyn Street, London. He took pride in designing and developing the finest furniture using the best of British craftsmanship and, with the help of his sons, developed the business.





Revolutionary Ideas

In 1921 the Parker's met Willi Knoll; a German fighter pilot. His revolutionary ideas to modernize comfort transformed the business. The coiled wire spring system, developed to redefine comfort, remains unchanged in many of our chairs today.

With its deep buttoned back and swivel pedestal base, the Statesman Chair was an instant hit during the 60s and 70s, quickly becoming a best seller and a modern status symbol.

Furnishing the BBC


In the 1930s Parker Knoll chairs were chosen to furnish most of the rooms and studios at the new BBC headquarters broadcasting house at Portland Place. In 1936 King Edward VIII announced his abdication from the throne at the BBC, he was sitting in a Parker Knoll chair.

For Parker Knoll the late 1960s were very definitive. The development of motion furniture began alongside iconic designs such as the Merrywood Collection and The Norton Group.
