

AUTISM-FRIENDLY SHOE-FITTING SERVICE

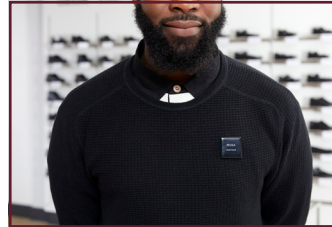
Find out more about what you can expect before your shoe-fitting appointment with us.



1 Arrive in comfortable time before your appointment



2 Follow the signs to the Children's Shoes department



3 Meet one of our Partners who will help with your shoe-fitting



4 Our Partner will explain how the measuring gauge works



5 You can then place each foot on the gauge. If you'd like some help, our Partner or your guardian can help



6 They'll then adjust the gauge to take your measurements



7 Once you've chosen a selection of shoes, our Partner will go to the store room and bring you some shoes to try



8 If you need some help trying on your shoes, you can ask our Partner or your guardian



9 You can then stand up and our Partner or your guardian will gently press the front of your shoe to check the fit on each foot



10 They'll also check that the fit is comfortable at your heel



11 You can then go for a short walk to check that your shoes fit comfortably



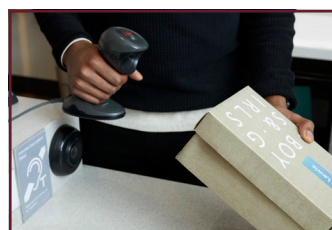
12 Once you're happy with your shoes, you can take them off. If you need help with this, our Partner or your guardian can help



13 Our Partner will then show you where the nearest till point is located



14 You may need to wait in a queue for a few minutes while other customers pay



15 Another Partner will then scan the barcode on the box and take your payment



16 Our Partner will then put your new shoes in a bag and thank you for shopping with us
