Care and Maintenance

Wood Furniture

Wood displays different grain patterns depending on which way it is cut - for example, the 'medullar ray' which can appear on oak furniture is a mark of good quality timber - these are just characteristics of the natural beauty of the wood.

All timber surfaces will change colour and mellow over time. New furniture will initially vary in shade from items that have been previously purchased.

How to care for your wood furniture

Your furniture is finished with a hard clear lacquer and painted surfaces, and should be dusted with a dry cloth. Spray polishes are best avoided as they contain silicones which may spoil the furniture's surface by building up over time.

The coat stand will endure most temperatures in the home but it is best to avoid placing furniture next to heat sources such as radiators or fires. Be particularly careful with solid wood as the lack of humidity caused by central heating can cause damage such as warping.

Do not allow water to stand on the surface – if the coat stand is splashed or becomes wet, dry immediately with a soft cloth.

Safety Instructions

- Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it – you can snap the legs off by dragging this item.
- After connecting the legs you will need to lift the item into a vertical position – ensure that you don't pivot the weight of the unit on the legs as you can easily snap them off.
- Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.
- Please take care when handling or moving the furniture as careless handling may cause damage or injury.
- Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly installed. Assembly should be carried out by a competent person. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled furniture.
- This coat stand has been designed as a free standing item – it has sufficient footprint to support a reasonable load of clothing and bags in a vertical position. However because of the nature of the coat stand do not position where it might be knocked as this can cause it to over balance and topple.
- No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused with the use of this product.
