

# FLOORING ROOM MEASURING GUIDE

The purchase of new flooring for your home is always exciting. To help you accurately estimate the amount of flooring you require, we have created this easy walkthrough guide on how to measure your room.

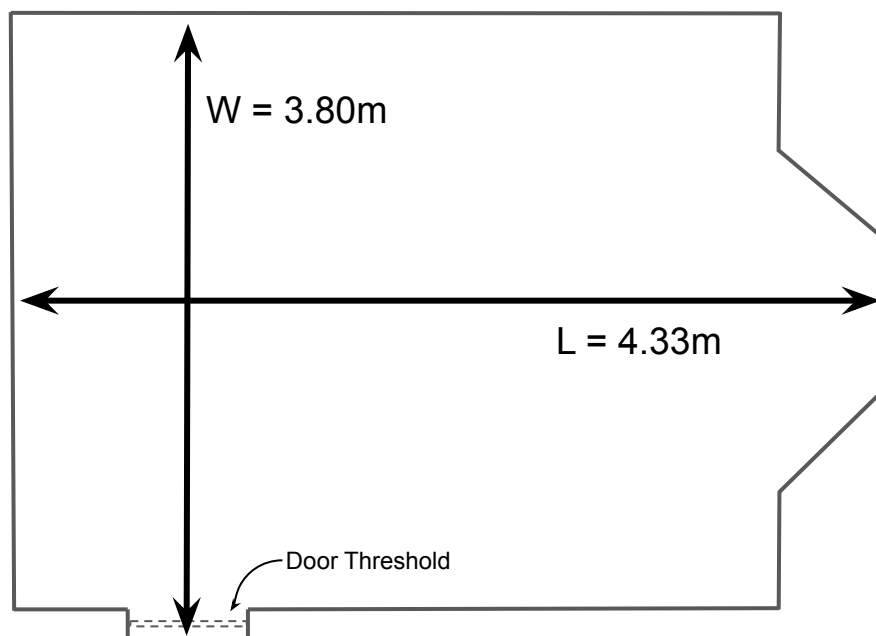
This guide will help you measure your room and for us to calculate the size of carpet or sheet vinyl you require.

In general you will need to just measure the widest and longest points of the room.

## EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

- Pencil
- Paper
- Metal tape measure (at least 5m)

## ROOM OUTLINE & MEASURING



Start by sketching the outline of the room, including the positions of the doors.

Here is an example sketch (*Don't worry about being perfect or to scale*)

This room example features a bay window which makes the room an odd shape.

This will not affect how you measure the room, as you measure the widest (W) and longest (L) points of the room.

*(Ensure you measure into any doorways passing any thresholds present)*

In this example, the measurements you would provide are **3.80m** and **4.33m**.
