# NEEDLES

1 pair 2¼mm (no 13) (US 1) needles 1 pair 3mm (no 11) (US 2/3) needles

# TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 3mm (US 2/3) needles.

## <u>Cool kid</u>

## BACK

Using 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>mm (US 1) needles and yarn A cast on 86 [94: 98] sts. **Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** P2, **\***K2, P2, rep from **\*** to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib for a further 10 rows, dec [dec: inc] 1 st at end of last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 85 [93: 99] sts. Change to 3mm (US 2/3) needles.

Beg with a K row, now work in st st throughout as folls:\*\* Work 70 [80: 88] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. (Back should meas approx 22.5 [25: 27.5] cm.) Shape armholes Cast off 4 [5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 77 [83: 89] sts. Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on foll 4 [6:6] alt rows. 59 [61: 67] sts. Work 33 [35: 41] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. (Armhole should meas approx 13.5 [15: 16.5] cm.) Shape shoulders and back neck Next row (RS): Cast off 4 [4:5] sts, K until there are 12 [11:13] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately. Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row, and at same time cast off 4 [4:5] sts at beg of 2nd row. Cast off rem 5 [4:5] sts. With RS facing, slip centre 27 [31: 31] sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn and K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

## FRONT

Work as given for back to **\*\***.

Work 56 [60: 66] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. **Place chart**

Next row (RS): Using yarn A K28 [32: 35], work next 28 sts as row 1 of chart, using yarn A K29 [33: 36].

Next row: Using yarn A P29 [33: 36], work next 28 sts as row 2 of chart, using yarn A P28 [32: 35].

These 2 rows set the sts – central chart with st st using yarn A at sides.

Keeping sts correct as now set and, when all 14 rows of chart have been completed, working sts above chart in st st using yarn A, cont as folls:

Work 12 [18:20] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape armholes

Cast off 4 [5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

77 [83: 89] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on foll 4 [6:6] alt rows. 59 [61:67] sts.

Work 3 [3:9] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape front neck

**Next row (RS):** K24 [24: 27] and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll 3 [4:4] alt rows, then on 2 foll 4th rows.

13 [12:15] sts.



Work 9 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. **Shape shoulder** 

Cast off 4 [4:5] sts at beg of next and foll alt row. Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 5 [4:5] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 11 [13: 13] sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn and K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

#### MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join right shoulder seam using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

#### Neckband

With RS facing, using 2¼mm (US 1) needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 31 [34: 34] sts down left side of front neck, K across 11 [13: 13] sts on front holder, pick up and knit 31 [34: 34] sts up right side of front neck, and 3 sts down right side of back neck, K across 27 [31: 31] sts on back holder, then pick up and knit 3 sts up left side of back neck.

106 [118: 118] sts.

Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for back for 7 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Join left shoulder and neckband seam.

## Armhole borders (both alike)

With RS facing, using 2¼mm (US 1) needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 86 [98: 106] sts evenly all round armhole edge.

Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for back for 7 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

See information page for finishing instructions.

## <u>Rock</u>

BACK

Work as given for back of cool kid.

FRONT

Work as given for back of cool kid to \*\*.

Work 18 [22: 28] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. **Place chart** 

Next row (RS): Using yarn A K29 [33: 36], work next 27 sts as row 1 of chart, using yarn A K29 [33: 36].

Next row: Using yarn A P29 [33: 36], work next 27 sts as row 2 of chart, using yarn A P29 [33: 36].

These 2 rows set the sts – central chart with st st using yarn A at sides.

Keeping sts correct as now set and, when all 52 rows of chart have been completed, working sts above chart in st st using yarn A, cont as folls:

Work 50 [56: 58] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Complete as given for front of cool kid from beg of armhole shaping.

#### MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join right shoulder seam using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.


## Neckband

Work as given for neckband of cool kid.

Join left shoulder and neckband seam.

## Armhole borders (both alike)


Work as given for armhole borders of cool kid. See information page for finishing instructions.
